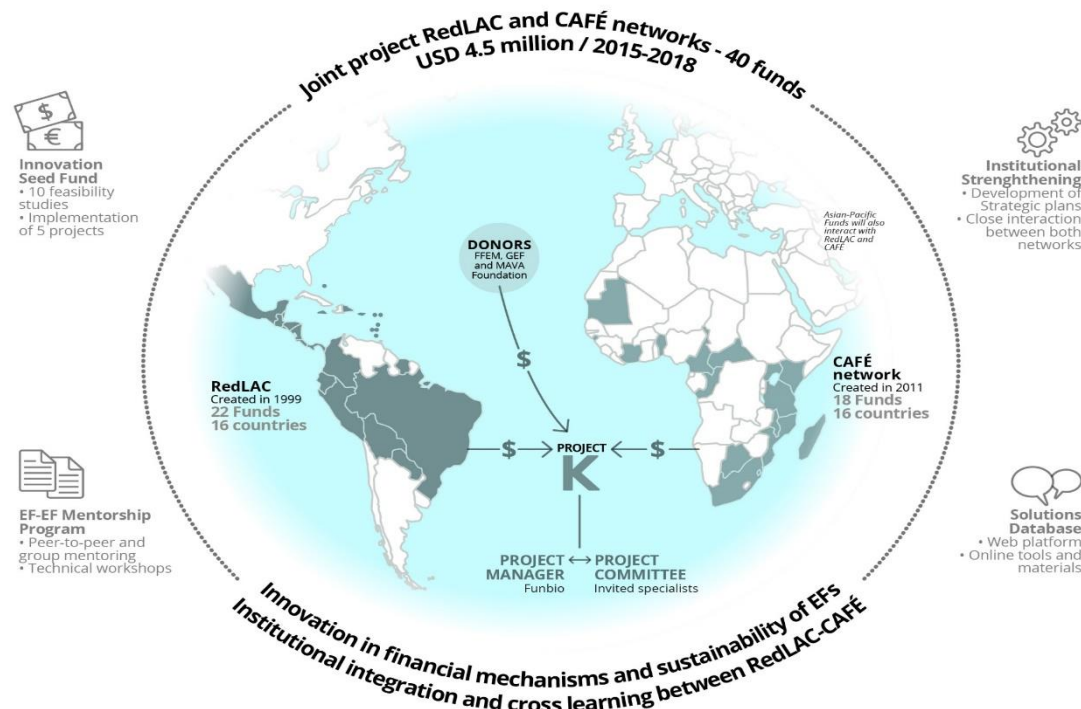

Project K – Knowledge for Action



- Project K, Knowledge for Action aims at enhancing Global Conservation through Peer-to-Peer Exchanges and Knowledge Management, joint project between RedLAC and CAFÉ.
- It is a special project built on the results and lessons learnt of the RedLAC Capacity Building Project, and aims to enhance Funds' portfolio of innovation, to diversify sources of funding to address conservation challenges and to promote knowledge and best practice transfer through peer-to-peer learning and online tools.
- Managed by FUNBIO, the project is being implemented between June 2015 and December 2018. It is supported by the following donors that in total contribute around 3 million dollars to the project: the French Fund for the Global Environment – FFEM, Mava Foundation and the GEF.

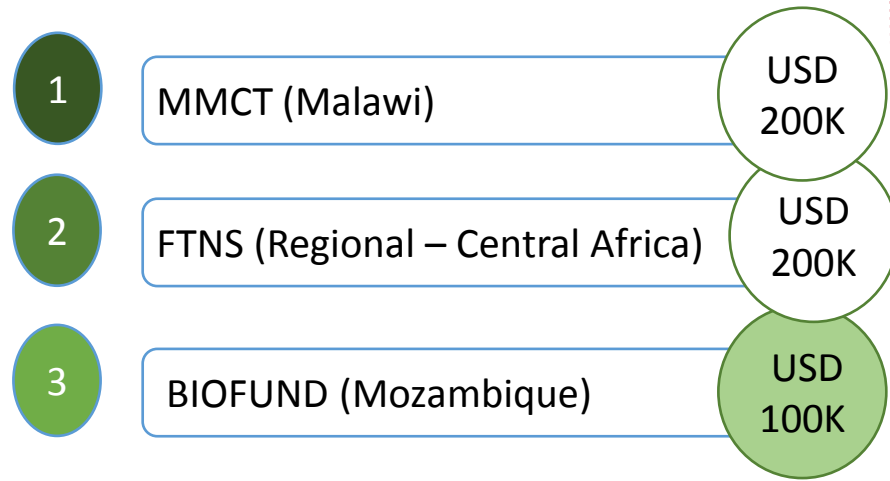

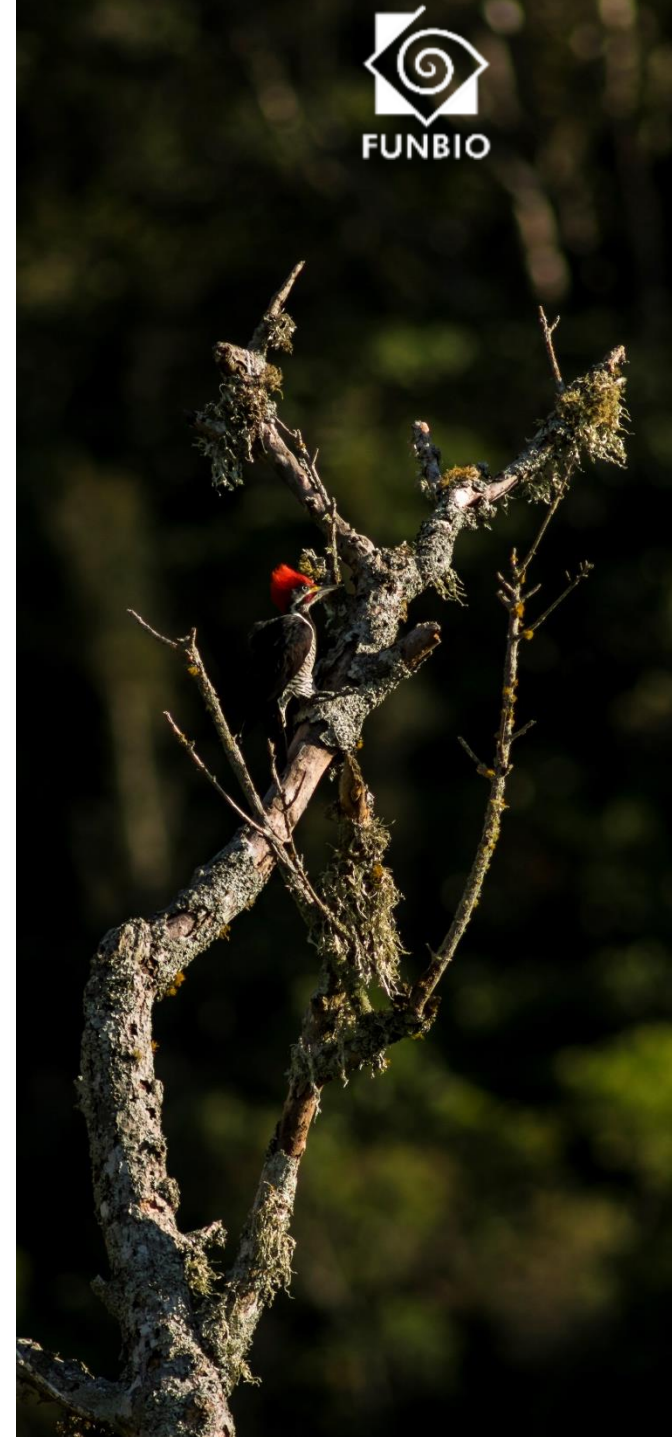
